THIRTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

THEME OF THE DAY

Hebrews addresses believers who felt dirt poor. Some had been thrown in prison. Others had been publicly insulted. Still others had had their property confiscated. And so Hebrews points them, and us, to an enduring treasure.


