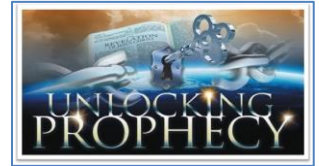

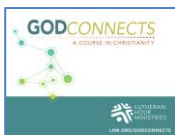
### A NEW YEAR! A NEW YOU!
