AS WE GATHER

This Sunday is Week 2 of the Gifted For More sermon series with the Sermon theme: *Everyone is a gift with gifts to share*. This is the foundation for the Gifted For More worship and Adult Bible study. The Gifted For More emphasis will help our congregation grow in awareness of the gifts God gives to each of us, and equip us for intentional use of God's gifts inside and outside of church walls. 
