

## TLO ANNOUNCES CHANGES IN PROTOCOLS FOR WORSHIP BEGINNING MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND:

1. Beginning Memorial Day weekend, hymnals and Bibles will be returned to the sanctuary.
2. Beginning Memorial Day weekend, all contact tracing protocols will be dropped. Worshipers will no longer be asked to pre-register online or sign-in when they arrive.
3. TLO will drop all social distancing requirements during worship beginning Memorial Day weekend.
4. Worship and Communion registration cards will be returned to the pews. Offering plates will continue to be placed on stands near the sanctuary entry doors.
5. Masks are no longer required during worship and are optional for those who prefer to wear one.
6. We will continue to only offer the wine using individual communion cups and distribute the Sacrament by continuous communion.

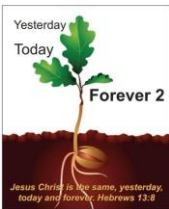

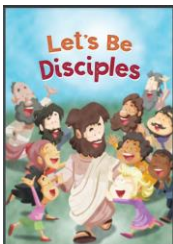
