AS WE GATHER

In this third service in The Light of Grace series for Advent, we celebrate that Jesus is the Light of the world who shines on us with his amazing grace, and we focus on the gracious gift of joy, exemplified in the life of Elizabeth.

*LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT WREATH

Three Advent candles are lit.

- P Today we light the third Advent candle, the candle of joy. When Mary, the mother of our Lord, visited her kinswoman Elizabeth, Elizabeth's unborn son John leaped for joy at the sound of Mary's greeting. Elizabeth was filled with joy, knowing that the promised Messiah would soon be born. We, too, rejoice as we prepare to celebrate our Savior's birth.
- C We will rejoice in the Lord, now and forever!

- P The prophet Isaiah foretold a highway, the Way of Holiness, a place where the redeemed would walk. Following that holy Way, the redeemed would live in the presence of God and know everlasting joy. Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life.
- C We will rejoice in the Lord, now and forever!

*CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- P In the midst of our joy, we are called to repent and acknowledge our need for a Savior. Let us confess our sins to God and ask his forgiveness.
- C Almighty God, while we rejoice in the birth of our Savior, we do not always find joy in following him. We seek to satisfy ourselves with earthly joy, joy that does not last. We turn away from the guidance of your Word and follow our own selfish desires. We do not walk in love as Jesus walked and instead put our needs ahead of the needs of others. Have mercy on us and forgive our sins for Jesus' sake. Lead us to find joy in following Jesus our Lord.
- P God had mercy on us and sent his Son to be our Savior. I announce to you that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- C Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!
