We are glad you are here today! Here are a few things we thought you would like to know to help you feel at home with us today. If you are visiting please introduce yourself to our pastor, a greeter or an usher. We love to make new friends!

Today we celebrate Holy Communion. Please speak with our pastor or an elder before communing if this is your first time receiving the Lord's Supper at TLO. The light-colored wine in the center of the individual communion tray is de-alcoholized wine, where the alcohol is reduced to .05%.



Parking Lot Work August 7 - August 17

Pine Bend Paving has confirmed that demolition of the school parking lot and the drive leading to the parking lot will start on Monday, August 7. They expect to have all of the old asphalt removed in one day. Concrete work will happen on August 8 and 9 to replace portions of the curbing and sidewalk. The first "lift" of asphalt will be put down on August 10 or 11 depending on the weather. The final lift of finish asphalt will be put down on Monday, August 14. The new asphalt then needs to cure for 3 or 4 days before being used. The new striping will be applied during the cure time.

From August 7 through about August 17, parking for church and school will be restricted to the cemetery side lot and the lot directly south of the church. Access the parking area from our main entrance by taking a hard left towards the cemetery and then turn right just before the church building.



Driveway limited Monday, July 31

The city water main to the new construction next door will cross the TLO driveway on July 31. The contractor will do half of the drive width at a time so that the driveway remains continuously open. Please use caution when entering our lot tomorrow.
